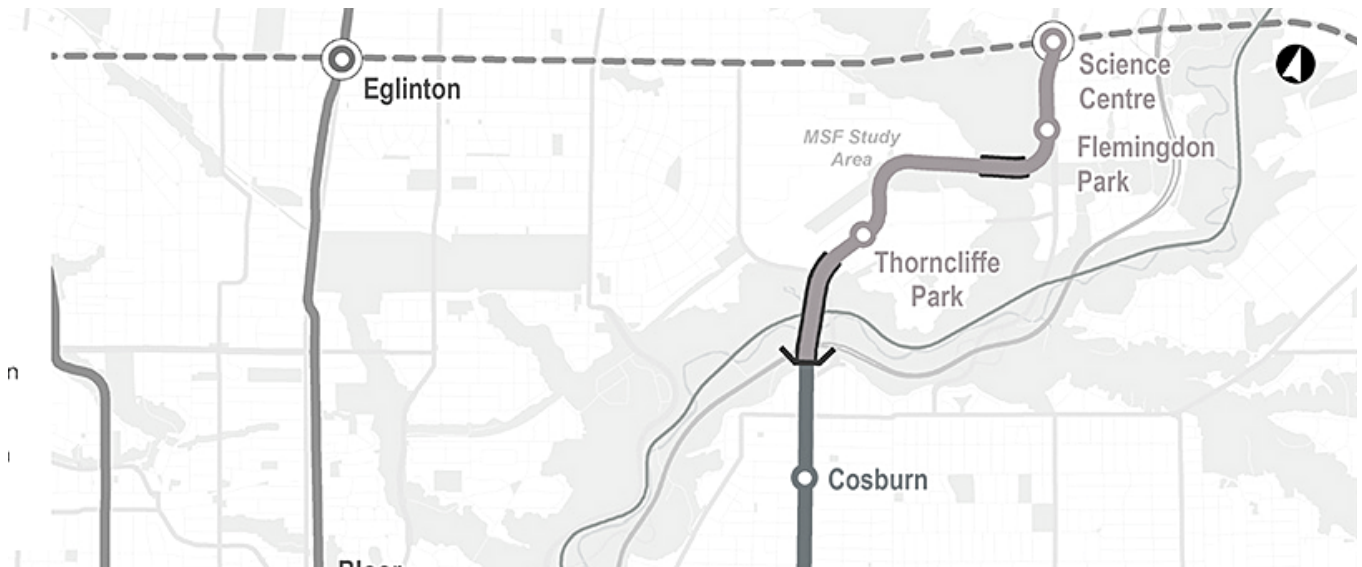

As of August 16, Metrolinx has started investigative drilling work on Village Station Road. They will be using small drill rigs and trucks to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx can begin to determine the construction approach for this project.
